



## SUBJECT MATTER KNOWLEDGE FOR MUSIC

Referring to the DOE regulations 603CMR 7.00 20(b), The following topics shall be included in an approved program but will not be addressed on the test of subject matter knowledge:

1. Singing skills and basic vocal production.
2. Sight singing and music reading, using standard notation
3. Intermediate level of keyboard proficiency
4. Use of technologies in music
5. Advanced vocal proficiency
6. Choral methods for treble, changing, and high school voices
7. Advanced instrumental proficiency on one instrument
8. Instrumental methods on strings, woodwinds, brass, percussion.

PRPIL is an approved program and since the above topics were not covered on the subject matter knowledge test, you need to provide "evidence" that you met the above requirements. "Evidence" can be coursework, seminars, workshops, private lessons, personal experience or teaching experience (Number of hours are not stated).

Please outline each of the above topics and list each piece of "evidence" that proves that you met the requirement.
